Do NOT touch or shift the clear rubber grommet that surrounds the sensor face. DO NOT glue housing into place until orientation and functionality is determined.

APPENDIX

Troubleshooting Vehicle Sensors

- Start with a general inspection of the sensor fitment.
 Check that both the sensors and the sensor clips are fully secure and the sensors are properly centered in the housing.
- Confirm plastic housing is in the correct mounting holes.
 Misplaced sensor housings could compress sensor and give false readings or faults.
- Use a clean microfiber to wipe the front face of the sensor
- Inspect connection. Be sure that the sensor is firmly seated into the harness.
- Run through several start cycles (i.e. fully turn the vehicle on and off).
- · Finally, disconnect the battery to reset the sensors.

WARNING

If your vehicle has adaptive cruise, please ensure that your adaptive cruise is working correctly once the Ranch Hand bumper is installed. Adaptive cruise may need to be cleaned or adjusted to ensure it functions properly. See your owner's manual for care of the adaptive cruise.

Special care should be exercised in the handling, storage and installation of Kaspar Ranch Hand equipment. The actual weight of each piece of equipment will vary depending on style and model. The weight of the equipment is sufficient in volume to warrant special care, assistance and in some instances, the use of mechanical equipment during the transfer and installation of the equipment. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- Open the hood and remove the plastic radiator cover. There will be (12) plastic clips.
- Remove the (4) 10mm bolts holding the grille in place. Carefully pry grille away from its position there will be (10) snap clips.
- 3. Remove the factory side brackets. There will be (3) 15mm bolts on each side.
- Remove the factory bumper by removing the two 18mm bolts from each side of the frame. They will be facing down.
- Lay the bumper down then remove the sensor and fog light wires (if present) from the bumper. You will have to remove the (2) large black bumper support plates to remove sensors.
- Reinstall the factory grille and plastic radiator cover.
- Remove the two black bumper mounting plate by removing the (4) 15mm bolts. The bolts will be used to install the Ranch Hand Frontend.
- Remove the side and bottom tow hook bolt.
 Mount the support brakets to the outer side of the frame rails. Reinstall the factory bolts.
- Install splash guard by removing (1) 10mm bolt. Place a 5/16" flat washer between the truck body and the splash guard. Reinstall factory bolt and use 5/16" bolt in the other hole.
- For the Legend frontends remove the outer sensor brackets from factory bumper. Install them into the bottom of the frontend.
- If fog lights are present, mount them to the to the fog light brackets provided and then to the frontend. Follow instructions in LBC151BP to install.
- 12. Mount the frontend to the frame by reusing the 15mm factory bolts. Level the frontend and then tighten bolts. Use 1/2" bolts to mount the frontend to the support brackets.
- Mount the license plate using 1/4" bolts to the bottom grille insert.
- 14. Hook up the sensor and fog light wires. You can run them through the square opening in the mounting brackets just below the top plate. Adjust the lights and sensors if needed.
- 15. Make sure all nuts and bolts are tight!!
